Of course, the speeds reached on Thursday had nothing in common with what awaits the competitors during the weekend, but we can bet that it won't take long for the recent winner of the Rallye du Condroz-Huy and the Rally van Haspengouw to understand how to use his emblematic car! A few metres away, Cédric Cherain was in the Porsche 911 Gr.4 of the August Porsche Addiction team, in the presence of Renaud Jamoul and Lionel Hansen. And if the Liège driver is confident, he knows that on Saturday, Lefebvre is likely to set a rather high pace.
